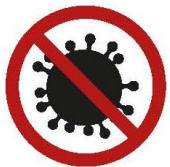

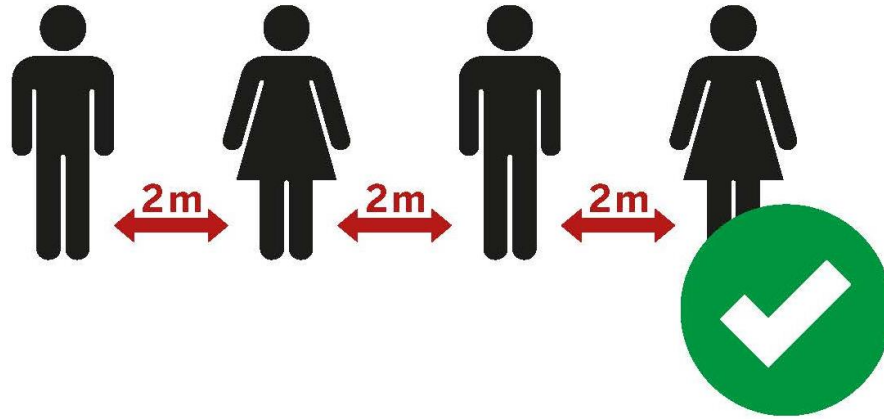
To protect against the corona virus

To protect the driving personnel/transport service providers/suppliers you have commissioned as well as our employees, and to maintain your procurement/production/supply processes, we are currently only allowing a limited number individuals onto the truck stops at the Leverkusen, Dormagen and Krefeld-Uerdingen locations, that is lorry drivers into the counter areas for freight transport inspection and expedition.

We ask you to inform your service providers

- with regard to the current protective measures,
- to instruct driving personnel to strictly follow instructions and in particular to keep the safety distance.

Building access control to ensure safety distance

At the truck stops at the CHEMPARK Leverkusen, Dormagen and Krefeld-Uerdingen locations, building access will be controlled by “marshals” in order to restrict the number of people in the counter areas and ensure a safety distance of 2 metres.

This will result in queues in front of the buildings at busy times. Lorry drivers are asked to keep the safety distance as marked on the floor.



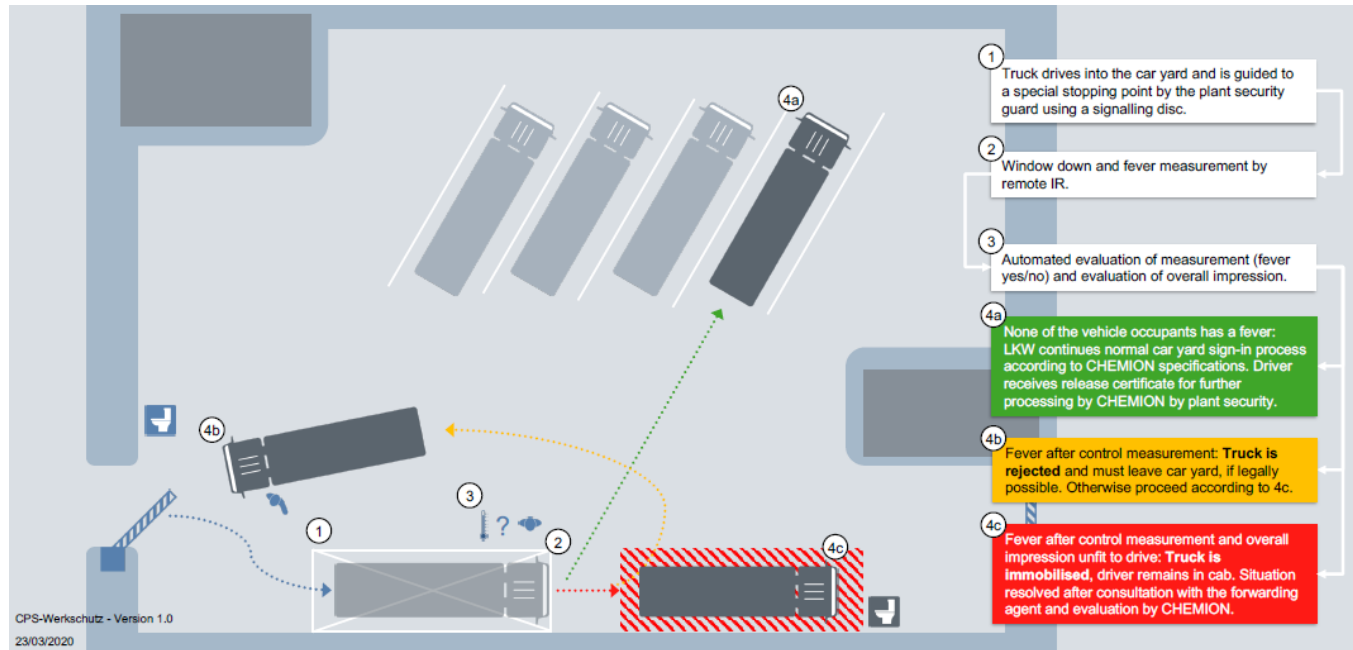
Markings on floor in the counter area to ensure safety distance

The floor at the counter areas has also been marked to identify the safety distance and the waiting areas.



Fever scans by factory security before entering the truck stop premises

The factory security is also performing fever scans upon entry to the truck stop premises. Only lorry drivers without a fever will be granted access to the premises.
